



## Although gathering in a group does not constitute ASB, the behaviour displayed by that group might Below are examples of what is considered 'unacceptable behaviour', which should be reported

| <ul> <li>Report to the police</li> <li>Using intimidating behaviour or abusive language</li> <li>Violence or threats of violence</li> <li>Using or dealing drugs</li> <li>Prostitution</li> <li>Any criminal behaviour e.g. shoplifting, cycle theft, arson</li> <li>Spitting, urinating or defecating in public</li> <li>Drunken, rowdy behaviour, this could include fighting, shouting and swearing</li> <li>Begging</li> <li>Obstructing or accosting pedestrians, cyclists or other road users</li> <li>Harassment of anyone</li> </ul> | <ul> <li>Report to the City Council</li> <li>Littering – including: food waste and packaging, drink cans, or bottles, drug paraphernalia (e.g. needles), cigarettes</li> <li>Uncontrolled dogs – including: fouling, dogs fighting or being aggressive to passers-by, constant barking</li> <li>Busking in a manner, which causes an obstruction, nuisance or disturbance</li> <li>Noise from within a property, including music or shouting so loud it causes a disturbance to others</li> <li>Environmental Health Services (Noise nuisance)</li> <li>Tel: 01223 457900</li> </ul> |
