

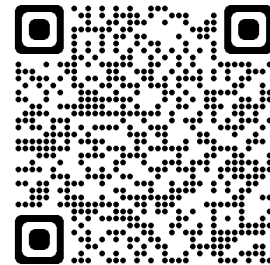
How to Join Neighbourhood Watch



Joining Neighbourhood Watch is completely free and easy to complete online.

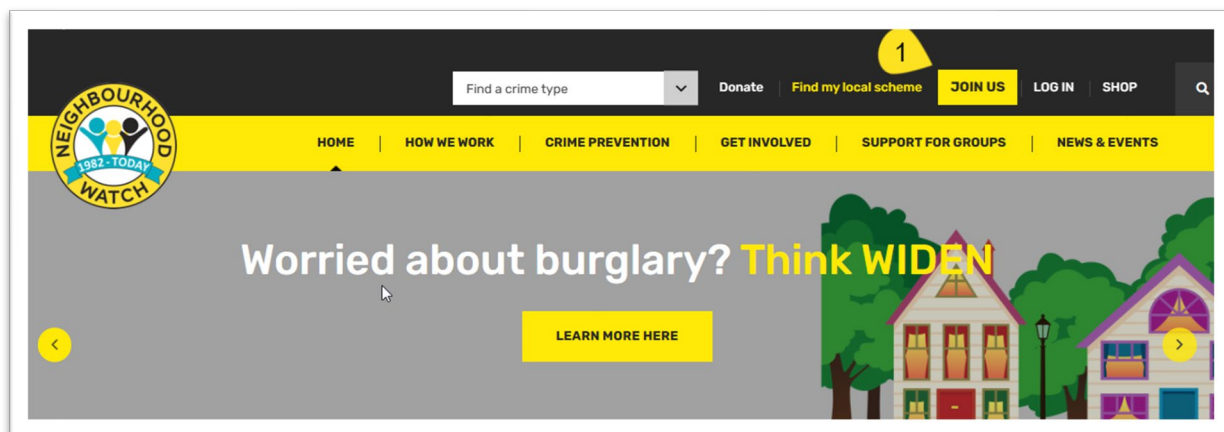
Step 1.



Step 2.





Log Out when you have finished.


